Welcome to the 2011 – 2012 Season of the Oak Bay Figure Skating Club. For this new season our club continues to work towards fulfilling our Mission and Vision.

## OUR MISSION

To provide a balanced quality, recreational and competitive program for those skaters living in the community of Oak Bay and surrounding neighborhoods on a year round basis.

## Junior Program

The Junior program is a class-structured session designed for skaters working on or having completed CanSkate badge 5 or 6. The emphasis of this program is basic skating skills. This program will enable your child to enter any ice sport discipline whether it is hockey, speed skating, ringette, or figure skating with above average proficiency.

*Registration in the Junior program includes group instruction as well as supervised practice during all sessions.*

*Private and semi-private lessons are available but are not a requirement.*

*The goal of the program is to develop strong skating basics. This will allow your child to quickly progress onto the Oak Bay Figure Skating Club's Intermediate session or will enable them to be proficient in other ice sports.*

*One coach will be instructing a group or supervising free time practice at all times. Private lessons will be rotated through out the session. However, Saturday's stroking session will have no private lesson time allotted to that 15 minutes.*

## Pre Junior Program

The Pre Junior program is geared toward talented Canskaters who have a keen interest in figure skating. Normally the Pre-Junior skater is under 7 years old and is working on stage 3 CanSkate badge or better. (Invitation only) Often we enroll siblings of the Saturday Junior program for the scheduling ease of our parents.

## Canskate

CanSkate is Skate Canada's Learn to skate program for beginners of all ages. CanSkate teaches fundamental movement and basic skating skills. CanSkate participants require a helmet, warm gloves and their own skates, as rentals are not available during Oak Bay Figure Skating Club sessions.

### Quality Program

We deliver the Skate Canada CanSkate program, which has been recognized world wide as the best learn to skate program for the last 25 years.

### Quality Structure

Your child's progress is monitored on a weekly basis, and they will be involved in the badge award program.

### Quality Instruction

All Oak Bay club coaches are registered Skate Canada professional coaching members, fully NCCP certified, and hold a valid first aid certificate. In addition to figure skating, many of our coaches have experience in hockey, power skating and speed skating, we strive to meet your skating needs.
